**Approval of minutes-** Barbara M. made a motion to approve the January 12, 2026 minutes. Susan seconded the motion and the minutes were approved.

**Treasurer's Report—** Cassie D. reported end of January account balance was \$7635.33, less the Good Neighbor fund of \$730.50 for a net balance of \$6904.83.

### Activity Reports-

- Coffee at the Clubhouse – January 9<sup>th</sup> activity was reviewed on at the January Social Committee meeting.

### Upcoming Events-

- February 14<sup>th</sup> - Mardi Gras
  - Event cancelled due to low number of responses; many residents who normally participate are in warmer climates.
  - The Social Committee will take this into consideration when planning future winter events.
- March 1 -Winter Beach Party
  - A second RAP Flyer will be sent to generate more interest in the community.
  - There was discussion regarding the temperature in the pool area and other areas in the lower level. The Committee will consider the Main Clubhouse Upstairs as an alternate location.
- March 22<sup>nd</sup> Meet and Greet for New Regency Residents
  - A suggested name for the invitation will be: Welcome Newcomer Party.
  - An email notice will be sent individually to new residents in two (2) weeks. A follow up reminder email will be sent in another two (2) weeks.
  - Approximately 50 residents will be invited to attend.
- April 23, Red Cross Blood Drive
  - Board has confirmed we cannot accommodate outsiders to participate.

**CAB Liaison—** Tom provided the following updates; Follow up is being done to contact a few households who have not responded to the census request. The Board is continuing to monitor the snow budget.
